Yearning for distraction from his tumultuous familial situation, Makai chooses to resist when his new found family is threatened.

Director's Statement: After spending months researching Toronto's Kiki Ballroom scene and getting involved in the community, I was able to gain the trust of this often marginalized group. Through collaboration we were able to create a film that not only accurately displays the modern Kiki Ballroom scene, but also diversifies the people and stories we see in queer cinema, and cinema as a whole. I am grateful of this community for trusting me with this representation and story.

Production Notes: Haus was fully funded by Canada Council for the Arts with grant money received in March of 2018. The film's cast is primarily non-actors who are involved in the Toronto Kiki Ballroom scene. Haus has began its festival run in June 2018.

Director Bio: Joseph Amenta has produced, written and directed short films that have screened at international festivals. His short, *Haus*, was fully funded by Canada Council for the Arts and screened at the Vancouver International Film Festival 2018 and Clermont-Ferrand 2019. An award winning graduate of film studies at Ryerson University, Amenta received the Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF) Avrich Industry Pass in 2018 as one of 10 promising Canadian filmmakers. He is currently developing his first feature.
