LOGLINE - 23 words

Set in the seemingly peaceful Okanagan, a distraught cannery worker discovers an invasive insect that could threaten the livelihood of her entire town.

SYNOPSIS

Short synopsis - 71 words

Robin is a cannery worker who struggles to get an abortion. When she finds an invasive insect in a peach at work, she turns her focus towards proving to her community that the danger it poses is real. As her obsession alienates her from friends and family, she sinks deeper into her task. *Until Branches Bend* is a psychological drama about how trouble beneath the surface will always come to light.

Medium synopsis - 145 words

Robin (Grace Glowicki) lives with her sister Laney (Alexandra Roberts) in the idyllic orchard town of Montague. While at work at the fruit packing house, she finds an insect that she believes to be invasive. When her boss Dennis (Lochlyn Munro) brushes away her concerns, Robin goes public with her finding. The reaction is swift: the factory shuts down, the farms are placed under quarantine, and the majority of the people in Montague find themselves unemployed - with Robin to blame. Meanwhile, Robin has been struggling to get an abortion. Unable to take control of her own body, she devotes herself entirely to finding proof that the bug she found was real. The parallel between these two invasions becomes clear as Robin loses herself in her obsession. *Until Branches Bend* is a psychological drama that shows how trouble under the surface will always come to light.

Long synopsis - 320 words

It's the height of summer in the valley town of Montague. After years of suffering the effects of the crop-destroying burrow moth, farmers finally celebrate an abundant season. When Robin (Grace Glowicki) finds a strange bug in a peach at work, her boss Dennis (Lochlyn

Munro) tells her to keep quiet. Robin's complicity weighs on her. It's personal, too: she's recently discovered that she is pregnant from a brief affair with Dennis. Robin decides to investigate the bug on her own, and finds that the bug fits the description of a highly invasive species. Robin blows the whistle.

Orchards shut down and workers are laid off throughout the region, including Robin's sister Laney (Alexandra Roberts) who picks fruit on a local farm. At an emergency town hall meeting, Dennis denies that Robin ever brought him the bug, implying that she made the whole thing up. The whole town turns on her. Robin begins a frantic search for proof of her discovery. Yielding no results, Robin is ready to give up on both the search and her own sanity. Then, Dennis' wife Isabelle (Quelemia Sparrow) pays Robin an unexpected visit. She presents Robin with the missing evidence, found hidden in Dennis' office.

Robin's celebration is short-lived. What her community needs is to continue working, and her victory can only result in further quarantine and personal estrangement. She chooses to keep the news to herself. Work resumes, and weeks of stress take their toll. Robin's body rejects the pregnancy. Laney takes care of her, a role reversal that aids their reconciliation. Just when they've caught their breath, a Locust-style swarm emerges from the earth: the insect eggs were on the roots of the fruit trees. The total devastation effectively bankrupts those in the farming community, forcing a mass exodus. Though Robin's relationship to her hometown is forever altered, the future doesn't look so bleak now that she and Laney are a team.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT ~ *shorter, 500 characters*

The film is inspired from visiting my grandparents in Summerland, an orchard town that is as wholesome as its name. I wanted to create underlying tensions beneath idyllic appearances. In this story, millions of insect eggs infest the roots of the peach trees that make up the town's core industry. Robin's unwanted pregnancy has yet to show. The invisible nature of these situations create the psychological element of the film, where Robin's efforts to do what's needed are dismissed at every turn.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT ~ 400 words

My grandparents live in Summerland, an orchard town that is as wholesome as the name suggests. Summers there have a striking atmosphere; the natural dusty palette of the landscape is at odds with the lush farms. The heat is palpable. The sensory experience spawned the idea for *Until Branches Bend*. The film examines the underlying tensions beneath idyllic appearances, and how a community can turn on one of its members when they step out of line.

In *Until Branches Bend*, trouble literally lies below the surface. Millions of insect eggs grow on the roots of the peach trees that make up Montague's core industry. Robin's unwanted pregnancy has yet to show. It is in Nature's nature to reveal itself despite human efforts to suppress it. This tension creates an uneasy tone which builds as the story progresses. After Robin is ostracised, surreal elements highlight her psychological mindset. These add an

idiosyncratic style that launches us towards the climax: the inevitable bug swarm.

We were slated to shoot *Until Branches Bend* in 2020, but the pandemic had other plans. Instead, we watched as themes from the film were projected throughout the world. We hoped that by the time we shot the film in the summer of 2021, the pandemic would be history. Instead, we suited up in our PPE and went to work as relentless wildfires traumatised the region (later followed by devastating floods). The film we shot is imbued with the intersection of climate change and a global pandemic. Then, in our final weeks of post-production, Roe v. Wade was overturned. The effects of abortion rights being stripped in the USA reverberates across the world, and Robin's struggle to access care feels more timely than ever.

In spite of the dire circumstances in which we filmed the project, there was a lot of joy and playfulness in the creation. Robin's relationship with her younger sister Laney is the heart of the story. Grace and Alexandra had incredible chemistry to begin with, and working with them to build off of that was magical. Building backstory with Quelemia and Cole for their characters (Isabelle and her son Zach) was another special experience. The producers created an environment that fostered support, respect and creativity. The crew is a talented, dedicated, and hilarious group of people. Every single day, I woke up excited for work.

I can't wait to share *Until Branches Bend* with the people who made it happen, and for their talent to be shared and celebrated with the rest of the world.

THE BODY REMEMBERS was picked up for distribution by Ava Duvernay's ARRAY, who released the film on Netflix and in Theatres in the US. The film received the prestigious Toronto Film Critics' Association Best Canadian Film Award, as well as 3 Canadian Screen Awards for Best Direction, Best Original Screenplay and Best Cinematography; and 3 Vancouver Film Critics' Circle Awards including Best Canadian Film. NEVER STEADY, NEVER STILL was nominated for 8 CSA Awards, again including Best Motion Picture, and won 3 awards from the Vancouver Film Critics' Circle, including Best Canadian and Best BC Film. His directorial work has shown at Berlinale and includes work with the NFB, CBC, and the Museum of Anthropology in Vancouver. He received his BFA in Film from Simon Fraser University.
